



Moving Energy Efficiency Forward In the Mountain State

Energy Efficient West Virginia (EEWV) is a coalition of non-profits, businesses, advocacy groups and individuals in support of energy efficiency programs and policies for West Virginia as a primary solution to key challenges and opportunities facing our state: rising electricity rates; power company decision-making not in the public interest; waste of energy resources; the need for jobs and a cleaner environment; opportunities to improve the efficiency of many older homes; and the need for public investment in energy efficient infrastructure.

Our mission is to promote energy efficiency among residents, local governments, public schools, businesses, and industrial users in West Virginia and to create a strong statewide coalition in support of energy efficiency programs.

The EEWV coalition empowers West Virginian’s with a stronger voice in how energy policy decisions are made. EEWV engages in public education; advocates for stronger public policy & standards; and researches and helps implement potential energy savings through energy efficiency measures.

The EEWV Coalition calls for:

- Establishing statewide goals for energy efficiency and energy savings with a timeline for achieving them.
- Requiring the Public Service Commission to engage in a transparent least-cost planning process that will require utilities to prioritize energy efficiency investments before investing in new generation.
- Establishing programs to help residents and businesses afford the upfront cost of comprehensive efficiency upgrades – similar to what many other states are already doing.
- Stronger investment in energy efficiency in schools to reduce energy costs and create a more comfortable and effective learning environment.
- Incentives for industrial energy efficiency for co-generation (combined heat and power – CHP) adoption.
- Adopting up-to-date energy codes for new homes and buildings.
- Improving the scope and effectiveness of low-income weatherization efforts.
